We take equal pleasure in accommodating so many groups, sports associations and corporate organizations that choose our venue for their tournaments, weddings, anniversaries and banquets.

*With the professional services provided by our Manager of Operations and his staff, Ledgeview is ready and able to provide our clients with full dinner and banquet offerings. We welcome various size groups with an exciting array of menu selections. Please feel free to discuss your needs with us. Please ensure that your meal arrangements are confirmed **30 days** prior to your event date. Our menu selections are included in this package for your perusal.*

Tournament booking and food service arrangements can only be confirmed by signing a "Terms & Conditions" form attached to this package and a \$500 non refundable deposit.

Dress Code & Outside beverages

Men—Shirts with collars and sleeves. Tailored dress shorts. Appropriate footwear. Women—Skirts, shirts, blouses, slacks or tailored shorts. Appropriate footwear. Rugby pants, cut-offs, athletic shorts, sweat pants, tank tops, undershirts, athletic jerseys, halter tops or any item of clothing with large cartoon graphics or commercial logos are not permitted on the golf course or in the club house. We sincerely thank our patrons in anticipation of their compliance of the dress code. However, non-compliance may result in the defaulting party being asked to leave the premises.

No alcohol is permitted to be brought onto the course. Failure to comply to Provincial Liquor Codes will result in a tournament guest being expelled from the premises. Ledgeview Golf & Country Club sells alcohol in the clubhouse at the concession stand and on the course in a drink cart.

Pace of Play—Marshal

For the enjoyment of all the golfers the following pace of play must be achieved: front 9 holes taking 2 hours, 15 minutes and the back nine taking 2 hours, 10 minutes. Ledgeview Golf & Country Club will invoice the tournament convener \$100 for a Marshall to keep up the pace of play and monitor the course for safety and damage purposes.

Inclement Weather

Tournaments will be played as scheduled unless the Head Professional and /or Superintendent determines the golf course to be unplayable. If Ledgeview Management deems the course unplayable due to extreme weather Conditions, a new date will be set for the tournament.

On Course Sponsorship & Signage

Tournament conveners are responsible for setting out and picking up their sponsorship signs. All signage on the course must be free standing. Banners and other items that are to be hung around the clubhouse area must be approved by Ledgeview's tournament coordinator.

KP's & LD's & Hole in One—(closest to the pin & long drive)

KP's & LD's must be provided to Ledgeview's tournament coordinator when the convener books the event. KP's & LD's will be placed on the course by Ledgeview Golf & Country Club. Hole in one requirements must be sent to the tournament coordinator before the event to ensure insurance requirements.

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Every shotgun package includes power carts

For example: a shotgun tournament booking for 100 players will come with 50 power carts. our pricing will reflect this inclusion.

We have a fleet of 60 power carts available. Shotgun tournaments are for groups of 100 or more players
Tee time tournaments are for groups of 16 or more. Extra power carts are available for \$50 per cart but must be reserved well in advance of the tournament in order to secure them

Tournament Terms & Conditions—2009

A **\$500** non refundable deposit is required to confirm your tournament. This must be submitted to the Clubhouse Office at least four (**4**) weeks prior to the function date. Deposits will be refunded back to the convenor 7 days after the tournament assuming that there are no damages to carts or to the course. If Ledgeview Golf & Country Club finds damage to the carts or the course an invoice will be sent to the convenor after the event to cover damages. The convenor will be responsible for liability unless he / she can provide a detailed list of participants that can be assigned to each power cart and have each participant sign a waiver at registration thus excluding the tournament convenor of liability. Ledgeview Golf & Country Club will assist the convenor in assigning power carts to these individuals.

Restaurant space, tournament dates & times will only be verified **after** a deposit is received. Customized menus or special dietary substitutes can be made available by our Chef upon prior request.

The balance of the charges is due at the end of the function by cash, certified cheque, or credit card. Ledgeview Golf & Country Club does **NOT** invoice after events.

Minimum final guest attendance guarantee is due by 12:00 noon, 7 days prior to function date. The Pro Shop will prepare the course for this number. Shotgun tournaments must guarantee a minimum of 100 players. The Clubhouse will prepare and set for dinner 5% above the guaranteed number.

In the event no guaranteed number has been received by the Clubhouse Office, the original contracted number will be charged, or the number in attendance, whichever is greater. If numbers increase beyond 5% of the guaranteed number, the clubhouse cannot guarantee there will be meals for those participants. Meal Prices are based upon one plate per guest including buffet style

Written notification of cancellation must be received ten (10) working days (two weeks) prior to the event or late cancellation charges of 50% of the contracted amount will be payable. Functions called off within 48 hours will be charged 100% of the contracted amount.

All hosted Food & Beverage services are subject to all applicable government taxes and 15% service charge, unless stated otherwise. Mandatory service charges are taxable by GST in accordance to the Canada Revenue Agency. Menu prices are subject to change without notice, however, Ledgeview Golf & Country Club will honour prices quoted for a 60 day period following event confirmation.

Ledgeview Golf & Country Club is not responsible for any loss or damage, however caused, to any goods, materials, personal belongings, business equipment or property of any kind brought on site or left on site by the lessee during the term of this agreement or following the termination of this agreement. Personal effects must be removed from the Golf Course at the end of each function, unless reserved on a 24 hour basis or upon prior approval of the Pro Shop or the Clubhouse Office. Security of any item's (e.g. laptop computer) left unattended in the clubhouse is the sole responsibility of the lessee.

Any items (i.e. hole in one prizes, banners, signage) to be displayed on the course must be approved by Ledgeview. Ledgeview will not be responsible for any items brought onto the course and left after the event.

Ledgeview Golf & Country Club reserves the right to inspect and regulate all private parties, meetings and receptions. The Pro Shop reserves the right to inspect all bags and carts before they enter the course to ensure compliance with Ledgeview's Policies. The Clubhouse does not permit nails, staples, tacks etc. to be used on function room walls or doors. Only masking tape is permissible. The Convenor will be responsible for any damages done to any part of the Clubhouse, premises or equipment, caused by any person attending the function and is also responsible for any replacement or repair charges. All signage must be of a printed material.

Provincial Liquor laws prohibit the service of alcohol before 11am and after 1am. All guests are required to leave 1/2 hour after last call. Smoking and Gambling are prohibited in all function rooms. The consumption of liquor other than that sold by the Clubhouse is prohibited. Guests are not to fill their golf bags with alcohol and drink these items on the course. If guests are found to possess these items they will be confiscated and/or the guest will be asked to leave. This is in accordance to Provincial Liquor laws. Food and beverage items in the clubhouse or on the golf course will be provided by Ledgeview Golf & Country Club unless otherwise agreed upon prior to the event based upon Fraser Health Authority guidelines.

Use of Ledgeview Golf & Country Club's name or logo must be approved by the Clubhouse Office and/or the Pro Shop.

Ledgeview Golf & Country Club cannot be held responsible, as per insurance regulations, for any of act of God (earthquake, flood, etc.) fire, bomb threat, riot or strike. Ledgeview Golf & Country Club cannot be responsible for any act of God that results in guests not being able to attend the function (heavy rain, snow, wind etc.). If Ledgeview Golf & Country Club is unable to host the function due to those occurrences listed above, a full refund of the deposit will be issued or another date for the function will be negotiated that is agreeable by both parties.
